MONUMENT DESCRIPTION

A brass disk set in the top of a concrete monument that is recessed 0.7 foot below the top of an iron monument case and cover. The Old City of Everett Monument Book describes this monument as a Standard City monument that is 17 feet North and 14 feet East of the center of the intersection.
